*Jonathan Lane did violate F.S.S. 316.193.1a by Driving Under the Influence of alcoholic beverages and/or chemical substances that affected his normal faculties to operate a vehicle safely and refusal to submit to test.			

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On April 29th, 2023, at approximately 0150 hrs, I was on routine patrol traveling northbound on SR5/US1 at approximately the 27 mile marker (MM) in my marked patrol vehicle. While driving northbound I observed a dark color vehicle parked in between two gas pumps at the closed Shell gas station on Ramrod Key, 27340 Overseas Hwy Ramrod Key, Florida 33042. The dark color vehicle appeared to be turned off. Approximately ten minutes later, at approximately 0200 hrs, while driving southbound on SR5/US1 I observed the same dark color vehicle still turned off and parked between two gas pumps at the closed Shell gas station.

Seeing a vehicle turned off and parked between two pumps at the closed Shell gas station was very uncommon, so I got behind the vehicle and exited my marked patrol vehicle. As I approached the dark color passenger car I was able to identify it as a silver, in color, Toyota bearing Florida registration tag PKA1S. I approached the passenger side of the vehicle and shined my flashlight through the windows. The windows had very dark tint and it was hard to see through them, but I did observe a person sitting in the driver's seat reclined back. The person appeared to be unconscious. I approached the driver's side of the vehicle and shined my light through the windows. I observed a white male reclined in the driver's seat with the seat belt buckled that appeared to be unconscious. I knocked on the window of the vehicle and announced myself as law enforcement in an effort to get the male's attention, but he remained unconscious. I opened the driver's side front door and observed a white male that was unconscious and very sweaty. The male appeared to be breathing very slowly and I observed a very slight rise in his chest and stomach, indicating that he was breathing. At this point I was able to identify the male as Jonathan Lane from prior work experiences.

I requested for a backup unit. Sgt. K. Fricke arrived on scene and also identified the male as Jonathan Lane. I and Sgt. K. Fricke announced ourselves as law enforcement as an attempt to get Lane to wake up, but he did not. I then performed a sternum rub on Lane's chest in an effort to wake him up, but he still remained unconscious. I then placed my hand on Lane's shoulder and shook him in an effort to get him to wake up. Lane did regain consciousness, but only for a brief moment. I requested rescue to come to the scene to check on Lane's wellbeing. As we waited for rescues arrival Sgt. K. Fricke had Lane step out of the vehicle and attempted to speak to him. Sgt. K. Fricke asked Lane if he knew where he was, he stated no. Sgt. K. Fricke if he was armed, Lane appeared to be confused by the question and felt his waistband to determine if he was armed or not. Lane appeared to not know if he was armed. Rescue arrived on scene and placed Lane in the back of the ambulance. Sgt. K. Fricke advised me that he could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from Lane's breathe.

Rescue transported Lane to Fishermen's Hospital, 3301 Overseas Hwy Marathon, Florida 33050. While at Fishermen's Lane was monitored by Dep. Daniels. Dep. Daniels stated that he could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from Lane's person. Lane was medically cleared and released from Fishermen's. I then walked outside with Lane and advised him that based on

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deputies observations I did believe that he was impaired by either alcohol and or narcotics and in actual physical control of his vehicle by sitting in the driver's seat, with his seat belt on, and with the keys to his push to start vehicle in a pocket on his person/in his pants. Lane was also the sole occupant of the vehicle.

As I spoke with Lane I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath, even while he was wearing a mask. I also observed that Lane's eyes were also droopy, bloodshot, watery, and glassy. Lane's reactions also appeared very delayed. I asked Lane if he would participate in voluntary Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's), he stated yes.

The SFSE's were performed on a paved parking lot at Fishermen's Hospital. There were no red/blue lights or flashers directly on Lane's face when he performed the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise.

Lane performed the following exercises:

1) Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus: During this exercise, I observed 5 clues. Lane was able to follow the stimulus, his eyes tracked equally, and he had equal pupil size. He had a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, had distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and had an onset of Nystagmus prior to a 45 degree angle in his right eye.

It should be noted that Lane was at times looking past me and not at the stimulus at all.

2) Walk and Turn: During this exercise, I observed 1 clue. Lane used his arms to balance.

3) One Leg Stand: During this exercise, I observed 0 clues.

Based on my training, experience, multiple deputies observations, Lane's performance on the SFSE's, and the totality of the circumstances I believed that Lane was impaired by either an alcoholic beverage and/or chemical substance which impaired his normal faculties to safely operate a motor vehicle. Lane was placed into custody and placed into the back of my patrol car. I transported Lane to the Marathon DUI room.

Dep. J.C. Marino then completed the Breathe Test Operator (BTO) portion. He informed me that Lane refused to provide a breathe sample.

Lane received the following citations:

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*FLORIDA DUI UNIFORM TRAFFIC CITATION NUMBER AHAFJ9E: For Driving Under the Influence of alcohol and/or drugs (F.S.S. 316.193).

Lane was issued a court date of 5/10/2023 at 0900 hrs in front of the Honorable Judge Wilson at the Key West Courthouse. Lane signed the citation and provided a thumb print on it without incident.

My body worn camera (s0469) and in car camera (Unit 1872) were both activated for this incident.

This incident occurred in Monroe County, Florida.

On 4/29/2023, I arrived at the Marathon Station DUI room to act in the capacity as a breath test operator (BTO). Deputy Connor Curry escorted the subject, Jonathan M. Lane ([REDACTED]) into the room. It should be noted, when Jonathan entered the room, I was able to smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath and person.

I asked Jonathan if he would take the breath test to which he said he would. I began the 20 minute observation at this point. Once the 20 minute observation was completed, Jonathan was heard to make a sound with his throat. I asked Jonathan to sit up and move towards me so he could provide the breath sample. Jonathan told me he wanted to do another 20 minute observation period due to him coughing something up along with regurgitating and swallowing it.

I did not witness anything in Jonathan's mouth nor did I see him regurgitate or swallow whatever he alleged to have had coughed up. I told Jonathan I was going to continue with the test. Jonathan told me he would provide me with a breath sample if he spoke to his lawyer first. I told Jonathan he could speak

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to a lawyer after the investigation was completed. I asked Jonathan if he would provide the breath samples and again he told me he would if he spoke to his lawyer first.

Jonathan was read the implied consent and was asked again if he would provide a breath sample. Jonathan again stated he would but only if he spoke to his lawyer first. I reminded Jonathan the investigation was still ongoing and he would contact his lawyer at a later time. The test was marked as refusal. I entered the pertinent information into the Intoxilyzer 8000, bearing serial # 80-007170.

I spoke to Deputy Hradecky, C. which was the acting supervisor at the time and advised him of Jonathan's allegations of him coughing something up and/or regurgitating. Deputy Hradecky C. advised me to conduct another 20 minute observation.

Again, I asked Jonathan if he would take the breath test to which he said he would. I began the 20 minute observation at this point. Once the 20 minute observation was completed, I asked Jonathan to sit up and move closer to me so he could provide the breath samples. Jonathan smiled, chuckled and shook his head. Jonathan once again requested to speak to a lawyer. I asked Jonathan multiple times if he would provide the breath sample and he stated he wanted to call his lawyer.

Jonathan was read the implied consent and was asked again if he would provide a breath sample. Jonathan stated he would provide a breath sample if he spoke to his lawyer first. The test was marked a refusal.

Post Miranda, Jonathan refused to speak to me and no further questions were asked. The paperwork and Jonathan, were turned over to Deputy Connor Curry.

DUI room arbitrator was active during this encounter and labeled with the case number.

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On 04/29/23 at approximately 0200 hours Deputy Curry asked me to respond to the Shell gas station in Ramrod. At this time I am Shift Bravo 2 supervisor, I met with Deputy Curry who told me he found off duty Deputy Lane asleep in the drivers seat of his vehicle parked at the gas pumps.

I walked over to the car, it was parked at the gas pumps. Deputy Lane was reclined in the drivers seat with his seat belt still connected. I watched for the rise and fall of Deputy Lanes chest to make sure he was breathing. Deputy Curry gave Deputy Lane a sternal rub to try and wake him. After a few minutes Deputy Lane began to gain consciousness. He seemed disoriented. I asked him if he was "OK". He replied in a very low voice "no". I asked him what was wrong, he replied he was feeling sick. I motioned to Deputy Curry to call for Medical response. While waiting for rescue to arrive I asked Deputy Lane where he was coming from. He said he was at a girls house in Summerland. I asked where he was going and he said Home.

I asked Deputy Lane if he was able to get out of the car. He said yes and very slowly got out of the car. He then leaned against the car until rescue arrived. I asked Deputy Lane if he was armed and he check his waist band and pockets and then said no. Rescue arrived and Deputy Lane went into the ambulance. At some point the rescue Captain said they were going to transport him to Fishermans hospital in Marathon. I asked Lane if he would like me to move his vehicle and he said yes. I asked Lane where the keys were? Lane removed the keys from his front left pocket.

I moved the car to a parking spot. I looked in the center console for his wallet and ID. I found a Ruger .380 firearm. I secured the firearm as to not leave it in the vehicle. Deputy Lane was given his car keys back at Fishermans hospital.

I notified command of the call involving an off duty Deputy. I told Deputy Curry to follow the ambulance to Marathon to check on the well being of Deputy Lane or for a possible DUI investigation. Deputy Daniels was designated to stay with Deputy Lane until he was released from the hospital. After release Deputy Curry conducted a DUI investigation. Based on the totality of circumstances it was determined Deputy lane was impaired. he was arrested with out incident. Command staff was again notified.

I tried to have small talk with Deputy Lane to determine what was wrong. Deputy Lane was flush with red blotchy skin. His eyes were droopy, watery, and partially closed. Deputy Lane seemed disoriented.
