On 1/20/18 Deputies were dispatched to a disturbance at the Residence Inn on Willowdale Rd Morgantown Monongalia County WV. Deputies were advised that there were multiple males fighting and their threats being made to shoot someone.

Upon our arrival we made contact with two rooms of males in various states of intoxication. I made contact with a male later identified as Quintin Graciano who was lying on a bed inside one of the hotel rooms. I announced myself several times but Graciano refused to get up.

I attempted to shake Graciano awake and he pushed me away. I eventually was able to wake Graciano fully at which time he struck me with his fist. Graciano then rolled out of the bed and a physical confrontation ensued.

Graciano continued to punch and kick me while I attempted to put him under arrest. I struck Graciano in the face using both my fist and elbow until he was flat on his back.

Graciano continued to fight and resist me on the ground and Deputies Mongold and I. Coe aided me in subduing him.

I used knee strikes while on the ground with Graciano to try and gain control of his arms. Graciano appeared to be reaching towards his waist band and I was unsure if he had a weapon. I sprayed Graciano with pepper spray in an attempt to distract him and gain control.

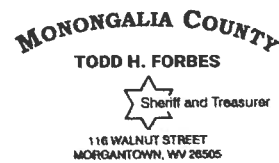
